## Answers to Trivia

1. Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, a descendant of DAVID: such is my gospel, for which I am suffering, even to the point of chains, like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. 2 Timothy 2: 8- 9
2. The word of God is not chained. It bears fruit. The Word of God is an important part of our worship. There are two main parts of the Mass: Liturgy of the WORD and the Liturgy of the EUCHARIST. (See CCC # 1346). Together, they form one single act of worship. They are both revered, hence there is the large stone ambo (where Scripture is read) and the matching large stone altar (where bread and wine are consecrated), both having lit candles nearby at Mass.
