TRIP TO THE CATHEDRAL FOR STUDENTS PREPARING FOR CONFIRMATION

Paperwork is now due for the field trip to the cathedral on Sunday, November 13th. Please bring it to the PREP Office. Parents: If you are bringing other students to PREP at 9:15 that morning, Jeff will be in the classroom so that your confirmation candidate may stay until leaving for the field trip (at 9:45). However, if parents prefer to bring their student at 9:45 to board the bus, that is OK, too. Mr. Rosfeld will be available to stay with any students coming at 9:15, but this is your option.

DOOR LOCKS We are in the process of converting our security system to all automatic door locks. The PREP door (near the PREP office) will now be automatically locking at 9:30 am. It will remain locked until 10:30 am. Please be sure to have your child to class on time. We try to have someone in the PREP office at all times (which is why we need parent volunteers in the office). However, in case you try to get in when the door is locked and no one is in the office, please wait until we return to the office. The phone # in the art room (Prep Office) is 792-4616. This also underscores the need to use the communication notes to let us know of unusual circumstances when you need to get into the PREP door. These measures are taken to increase security for our students. Thank you for your cooperation.
