Answers to Trivia

2. The rich man sees the poor man at his door, probably often. He does not notice him or care. This is a sin against God, and is mentioned in CCC # 2094- a sin of INDIFFERENCE (complete the word). What does this word mean? Indifference means (dictionary) without interest or concern. The catechism puts it into a faith perspective: It says that when we are indifferent, we refuse to see the needs of others and to offer help. We are blind by choice, or we convince ourselves that it is not our problem. In our indifference, we are neglecting to live our Christian calling to serve.

New this year: Students must answer both questions. The answer to the second question should be a complete sentence, and the result of a discussion within your family. “CCC” is catechism reference #. If you need a catechism, we sell them in PREP office, \$9 donation.
