All First Reconciliation services begin at 6:00 pm, but families with children receiving the sacrament for the first time have been assigned a time to arrive. This insures that the students do not need to wait for long periods of time.

The Service is open to all parishioners, but families without a child receiving the sacrament for the first time are asked to arrive at 6:45 pm.
