- ❖ Pray for your Prayer Partner daily, if possible.
- ❖ Write a note of encouragement (from you to the candidate), and mail it to the All Saints parish office, postmarked by Jan. 8, 2018 (so that we have it in time for their retreat on Jan. 15). These notes of encouragement will be given to them at the retreat. Be sure to write the candidate's name on the OUTSIDE of the envelope.
- ❖ **OPTIONAL:** You are invited to the Confirmation Mass at St. Peter in Chains Cathedral downtown at 2:00 pm on Sunday, February 25, 2018.
- ❖ **OPTIONAL:** You may send a Confirmation card to the Parish Office by February 12 to be given to him/ her on Confirmation day. The candidate's name must be written on the OUTSIDE of the envelope.

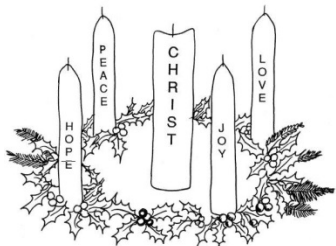
